St. Mary School Parent Service Hour Options

All families must complete 10 hours of service each school year to St. Mary School. St. Mary Parish service hours do not count toward the 10-hour St. Mary School service requirement. Volunteering to assist with Religious Education, Vacation Bible School, the Taste of St. Mary, etc. are all examples of service to St. Mary Parish, not St. Mary School. Below are the options that do satisfy the 10-hour St. Mary School service requirement. Service hours completed for activities not listed below must be pre-approved by St. Mary School.

- 1. Bake Sales
 - providing baked goods (1 hour credit max per monthly bake sale)
- 2. Chair a Fundraiser (Sandwich Fair, Fundraising Event, Walk-A-Thon, etc.)
- 3. Chaperone a Field Trip
- 4. Classroom Parties (Christmas and Valentine's Day)
 - organizing/planning, running the event, cleanup
- 5. Coaching
- 6. Dance Supervision
- 7. Fundraiser Assistance
 - Help setup, cleanup, decorate baskets, sell tickets, etc.
- 8. Lunch Recess Supervision
- 9. Represent St. Mary
 - At nearby parishes after weekend masses
 - At local community events (YMCA's Healthy Kids Day, Plano's Heritage Fest, Oswegoland Prairie Fest, etc.)
- 10. Miscellaneous St. Mary School Events
 - 8th Grade Graduation (grade 7 parents)
 - Field Day
 - Kindergarten Graduation (grade 1 parents)
 - Kindergarten Orientation
 - Library
