

# Uniform Dress Code

- ✚ Students can only wear the apparel items listed below.
- ✚ The administration has final jurisdiction regarding the dress code and can amend it at any time.
- ✚ Any article of clothing, accessory, hairstyle, etc. deemed to be a distraction to the learning environment can be prohibited at any time. This determination is made solely by a teacher or administration.
- ✚ A student out of dress code can lose code of conduct points (grades 5-8), be sent home, held in the office out of class, or be excluded from returning to school until he/she is in full compliance with the dress code according to the administration.
- ✚ If a student has a medical need that requires him/her to be exempt from any part of the dress code, a physician's statement is required (example: wearing a face shield in lieu of a mask).
- ✚ Students cannot wear clothing that supports/implies the use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, sex, violence, teachings against the Catholic Church or that are demeaning/discriminatory.
- ✚ Students are to be covered from the shoulder to the knee at all school-sponsored events. This includes the Walk-A-Thon, the Talent Show, Dances, Out of Uniform Days, etc. If a student wears a top/dress without sleeves (basketball jersey, dress with spaghetti straps, strapless dress, etc.), an additional article of clothing must be worn under or over the top/dress.
- ✚ Form-fitting articles of clothing (yoga pants, tights, leggings, etc.) can only be worn underneath an additional dress code approved article of clothing (skirts, jumpers, shorts, etc.). This rule applies to all school-sponsored events. A student who wears form-fitting clothing on their lower body and a long top on their upper body is in violation of the dress code.
- ✚ Students cannot play in the snow on school grounds at any time (before school, recess, after school, etc.).

## *Uniform Days Dress Code:*

- ✚ Boys must be clean shaven.
- ✚ Cargo shorts/capris/pants, painter shorts/capris/pants, and jeans/denim shorts/capris/pants are prohibited.
- ✚ Clear nail polish only is permitted for girls.
- ✚ Clothing with rips/holes is prohibited. Clothing designed with rips & patches is also prohibited.
- ✚ Cologne/perfume/body spray is prohibited.
- ✚ Girls can wear minimal make-up. The determination of "too much" make-up will be made exclusively by a teacher or administration.
- ✚ Hair cannot be cut/styled in a manner that is a distraction to the learning environment. Haircuts/hairstyles featuring shaved words, numbers, symbols, etc. are prohibited. Boys' hair must be cut/styled above the collar, eyebrows, and ears.
- ✚ Hair color/dye/bleach/highlighting is prohibited. This includes natural colors.
- ✚ Hats/hoods are not allowed to be worn inside of the school.
- ✚ Lanyards are allowed, but they must be kept out of sight.
- ✚ Logos (Under Armor, Nike, Adidas, etc.) are only permitted on shoes, socks, and on the rear right pockets of uniform dress pants and dress shorts. This includes if an article of clothing has a St. Mary insignia on them.
- ✚ Sewn-on pockets on shorts/capris/pants/slacks are not allowed.
- ✚ Socks must always be worn.
- ✚ Temporary tattoos are prohibited.
- ✚ Uniform tops (polos, collared blouses, turtle necks, etc.) must be worn and tucked in under all sweatshirts, sweaters, and St. Mary spirit wear fleeces/pullover jackets.

<b>Lower Body</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ Solid navy blue or khaki dress shorts or pants (small logo near rear right pocket allowed).</li> </ul> <p>* Khaki or navy blue jeans/denim pants/shorts are not allowed.</p> <p>*Sewn-on exterior pockets are not allowed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ Students grades 6-8 must always wear a solid brown, black or navy blue belt.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ Solid navy blue or khaki loose-fitting dress pants/slacks (small logo near rear right pocket allowed), skirts or jumpers.</li> <li>✘ Solid navy blue or khaki dress shorts with length no higher than at the knee or loose-fitting capris can also be worn (small logo near rear right pocket allowed).</li> </ul> <p>* Khaki or navy blue jeans/denim pants/slacks/shorts/capris are not allowed.</p> <p>*Sewn-on exterior pockets are not allowed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ Students grades 6-8 must always wear a solid brown, black or navy blue belt with pants/slacks, shorts or capris.</li> <li>✘ Uniform patterned (navy and French blue plaid with thin yellow and red stripes) drop waist jumpers or kick-pleat skirts with length no higher than at the knee can also be worn.</li> <li>✘ Solid navy blue or black gym shorts, tights, or leggings can be worn underneath jumpers and skirts.</li> </ul>
<b>Socks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ Solid navy blue, white, brown or black (logos allowed).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ Solid navy blue, white, brown or black (logos allowed).</li> </ul>
<b>Shoes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ Tennis shoes with laces (logos allowed). <b>Jewelry</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ A wristwatch and a religious necklace can be worn.</li> <li>✘ A bracelet per arm can also be worn.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ A wristwatch, a religious necklace, and simple functional hair accessories can be worn.</li> <li>✘ A bracelet per arm can also be worn.</li> </ul>
<b>Piercings</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ Boys cannot have piercings.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✘ One piercing in each ear lobe is permitted. Cartilage, eyebrow, nasal, lip, tongue and all other piercings are prohibited.</li> <li>✘ Only stud earrings are allowed. Hoop earrings and earrings that dangle below the earlobe are prohibited.</li> </ul>
