

Uniform Dress Code

- ✠ Students can only wear the apparel items listed below.
- ✠ If a student has a medical need that requires him/her to be out of dress code, a physician's statement is required.
- ✠ At no time can a student wear clothing that supports/implies the use of drugs/alcohol, sex, violence, teachings against the Catholic Church or that are demeaning/discriminatory.
- ✠ Students are to be covered from the shoulder to the knee at all school sponsored events. This includes the Walk-A-Thon, the Talent Show, Out of Uniform Days, etc. If a student wears a top/dress without sleeves (basketball jersey, dress with spaghetti straps or no straps, etc.), an additional article of clothing must be worn under or over the top/dress.
- ✠ Form-fitting articles of clothing (yoga pants, tights, leggings, etc.) can only be worn in combination with additional dress code articles of clothing (skirts, jumpers, etc.). This rule applies to all school sponsored events. A student who wears form-fitting clothing on their lower body and a long top on their upper body is in violation of the dress code.
- ✠ Students cannot play in snow during recess.
- ✠ Any article of clothing, accessory, hairstyle, etc. deemed to be a distraction to the learning environment can be prohibited. This determination is made solely by the teacher and/or administration.
- ✠ A student out of dress code can be held out of class or sent home until he/she is in full compliance with the dress code according to the administration.
- ✠ The administration has final jurisdiction regarding the dress code and reserves the right to amend it at any time.

Uniform Days Dress Code:

- ✠ Boys must be clean shaven.
- ✠ Cargo shorts/capris/pants, painter shorts/capris/pants, and jean-style shorts/capris/pants are prohibited.
- ✠ Clear nail polish only is permitted for girls.
- ✠ Clothing with rips/holes is prohibited.
- ✠ Cologne/perfume/body spray is prohibited.
- ✠ Girls can wear minimal make-up. The determination of "too much" make-up will be made exclusively by the teacher and/or administration.
- ✠ Hair cannot be cut/styled in a manner that is a distraction to the learning environment. Haircuts/hairstyles featuring words, number, symbols, etc. are prohibited (shaved). Boys' hair must be cut/styled above the collar, eyebrows, and ears.
- ✠ Hair color/dye/highlighting is prohibited.
- ✠ Hats/hoods are not allowed to be worn inside of the school.
- ✠ Only shoes can feature a logo. Tops, bottoms, socks, accessories, etc. featuring a logo (Under Armor, Nike, etc.) are prohibited. This is true even if an article of clothing has a St. Mary insignia added to them.
- ✠ Socks must always be worn.
- ✠ Tattoos are prohibited.
- ✠ Uniform tops (polos, collared blouses and turtle necks) must be worn under all sweatshirts/sweaters.
- ✠ Uniform tops (polos, collared blouses and turtle necks) must be tucked in at all times, even under a sweatshirt/sweater.

Piercings	✠ Boys cannot have piercings.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✠ One piercing in each ear lobe is allowed. Cartilage, eyebrow, nasal, lip, tongue and all other piercings are prohibited. ✠ Only stud earrings are allowed. Hoop earrings, earrings that dangle below the earlobe, etc. are prohibited.
